ISBE's Travel Award Committee has now completed its review of the 2022 ISBE travel award applications. This email serves as your official notification that you've been awarded \$400 (USD) to offset the costs of traveling to the International Society for Behavioral Ecology conference to be held in Stockholm, Sweden on July 28tth-August 2nd, 2022.

We received a total of 182 applications. Funding decisions for eligible applicants were based on our evaluation of the appropriateness of the abstract's topic for a behavioral ecology conference and the likely impact of the research results on the field of behavioral ecology. Award amounts are based on budgetary limits and regional costs of airfares as of midto-late February. Awards to applicants who are ineligible to receive a discounted student/developing nations member conference registration fee include a supplement of \$100.

Awards will be distributed as checks (in USD) drawn from ISBE's Bank of America account. Your award check will be available when you register onsite at the Stockholm conference.

As a reminder, receipt of an award is contingent on your being a current member of ISBE If you have not yet updated your membership for 2022=2023, please do so as soon as possible so that OUP's records will reflect your membership. Finally, if your plans change and you decide not to attend the conference, please contact me so that we can reallocate our funding for the awards.
